The number of students is growing rapidly in our neighbourhood. To accommodate the student population at Judith-Jasmin, the CSDM's Council of Commissioners approved the addition of temporary classrooms for the next school year. This way, children will be able to attend their local schools, thus limiting their commute.

Work on this project will begin on June  $4^{th}$  and continue for a few weeks. Please see the exact location of the temporary classrooms on the attached map.

We will minimize noise and movements on the job site, work will focus on the classrooms exterior during the first week and end with interior fittings. Measures will be taken to ensure a safe and peaceful environment according to the standards established by the CSDM, in partnership with the borough, the City of Montreal, and all labour and construction regulatory agencies.

To make sure that those temporary modules fit well in the borough's architectural landscape, our students will take part in *Lab éphémère*, a greening and murals project. 
